

The Museum's unique 2+ acre property is a perfect location to host a private party or wedding. The property can accommodate small parties inside or large ones up to 250 people under a tented area.

The Boat Shops on the property can accommodate small parties of up to 60 people under cover. Though they are not winterized buildings, they can be used from May – September.

The Captain Jonathan Parker House is smaller and accommodates up to 50 people. However, it is winterized and can be rented throughout the year for small gatherings. There is a small kitchen area in the Parker.

The grounds of the museum are perfect to host a larger tented event. Tents can nestle between the buildings surrounded by a cedar grove or in our back field. There is plenty of parking; enough to hold 60 cars.

The policy of the Museum is to be kept apprised of all businesses contracted out relating to the rental period and reserves the right to cancel a rental agreement should this not be adhered to. All caterers must be licensed and insured. Proof of each is required. Prices above are for one, 6-hour event. Each hour beyond that period is charged at \$250. A credit card must be on file as a security deposit. A certificate of liability insurance from the rental party must also be on file with the museum.

If dates are available, you may add on a rehearsal dinner or a Sunday brunch to your event using your tent on the grounds for an additional \$750 fee each. A 50% non-refundable and non-transferable deposit is required to reserve a date.
